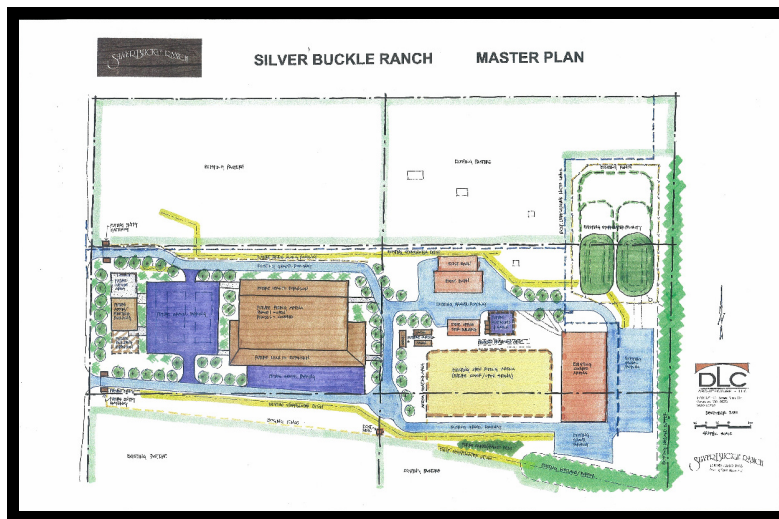




Silver Buckle Ranch Master Plan

The Ranch recently completed a Master Plan to provide long-term planning into the future and to assist with fundraising efforts. Silver Buckle Ranch has been operating in Clark County since 1977, offering a variety of equine-assisted programs. These include therapy programs for disadvantaged and challenged youth, as well as riding lessons and rodeo related activities for the public. Strategic planning undertaken in 2005 provided the basis for planning efforts. As part of the planning process, expansion opportunities were studied to best utilize the core areas at the Ranch and to improve overall pedestrian and traffic circulation. These planning efforts will help the Ranch make the best use of their facilities and property expanding their community programs and events. This master plan not only looked at providing additional facilities in the future but also looked into opportunities to improve existing buildings and facilities.
